- 1. Muybridge shot his first film to help the governor of California settle a bet by filming a horse race. He set up 40 different cameras with trip wires that each took a still shot, and were strung together to make a moving picture.
- 2. Sound synchronization affected the film industry by using the vitaphone to make musicals and gangster films a reality.
- 3. The Golden Age of Hollywood ended because of the introduction of television, which challenged the film industry to get the audience into the theater seats.
- 4. What is significant about French New Wave is that it introduced a new kinetic style of film making. Films shot with very low budget ended up getting the attention of the film studios.
- 5. Genre is the difference between story types and how they are told. This is important for setting the intention of the film.
